Reading Books

In F2, children take home reading for pleasure books to share the joy of reading with their families. Once they have reached set 1c, they begin to read from the ditty sheets, then move onto red books.

In year 1, children follow their phonics lesson with a grouped reading lesson, where the children read from their corresponding sound reading book.

In year 2, children are taught phonics or spelling where necessary, and the reading is taught in a separate reading lesson, with books closely matched to their reading need.

We also send books home to match their school readers.
